Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondents No. 2 and 3 to further investigate the matter in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Heard.
3. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner got the aforesaid FIR registered and had also supplied the CCTV footage to the concerned Investigating Officer which has not been taken care of by the said Investigating Officer for mentioning the appropriate offences in the FIR and aggrieved by the same, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 18.06.2024



(Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal, but the same is still pending consideration.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation shall be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner according to law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwa, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 18.06.2024 (Annexure P-4), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
