The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant annual increments and other consequential benefits with interest as the petitioner has completed her probation period in terms of office order dated 15.09.2023, Annexure P-6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make fresh representation before the third respondent-Registrar, Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naman Jain, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos. 2 to 4, and submits that in case such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the concerned authority, Registrar, Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before third respondent-Registrar, Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma University of Health Sciences, within two weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the officer concerned by passing speaking order thereupon, within six weeks of receiving the representation.
