1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue in the present petition is whether the candidates who have B.Ed. qualification to their credit and have also passed six months Bridge Course, should be treated eligible for appointment for the post of ETT keeping in view the Notification of the NCTE dated 23.08.2010 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that even in the impugned order dated 05.06.2024 (Annexure P-10), the said aspect has not been noticed by the respondent-State, hence, the petitioners in fact have already filed a representation dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the



respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, keeping in view the advance copy given, appears on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, no order has been passed on the representation dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) so far, appropriate order will be passed within a period of three weeks from today and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and will be duly conveyed to them.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
