SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. On 28.10.2024, this Court passed the following order:-

“Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were owners of the land in the revenue estate of Village Harshi Pind, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur which was acquired for widening and four-laning of Jalandhar-Pathankot section of National Highway. He submits that the compensation awarded to the land owners has been settled upto the Supreme Court and the SLP filed by the respondents was dismissed vide order dated 19.09.2019, (Annexure P-3).

Counsel further submits that petitioners have filed execution petition for release of the



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compensation amount which is pending for the last more than two years. He submits that some amount has been released but the balance still remains to be paid to the petitioners.

Notice of motion to the respondents.

Mr. Abhilaksh Gaind, Mr. Rakesh Roy and Mr. Aman Kumar Sirswa, Advocates (through V.C.) accept notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Mr. Brijesh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

List on 12.12.2024.

Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit with the Executing Court the balance compensation amount as per its calculation prior to the date fixed before this Court with the Executing Court.”

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to issuance of warrants of attachment by the Executing Court, an amount of Rs.77,15,287/- lying in the account of respondent No.2 with the Indusind Bank, Model Town Branch, Jalandhar, was attached and by order dated 07.11.2024, Executing Court has issued notice to the Branch Manager directing him to remit the amount on or before 28.01.2025.

3. In view of the above development, revision petition is disposed of. Executing Court is requested to conclude the proceedings as expeditiously as possible.
