1. The prayer in the present Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside the seniority list dated 19.07.2013 (Annexure P-3) to the extent that the petitioner has been shown to be junior than that of respondent Nos. 3 to 5.
