1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that he should not be replaced with a candidate on the same terms on which the petitioner is working.
2. Reply has been filed by the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the University submits that keeping in view the reduction of students in the department where the petitioner was working, the services of the petitioner have been dispensed with and no other person has been appointed in place of the petitioner on the

same terms and conditions. Therefore, no grievance can be raised by the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the work pertaining to the post on which the petitioner was working still exists and, therefore, the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the University submits that in case any representation is given by the petitioner for her claim, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and will be duly conveyed to her.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.

8. Pending miscl. application, if any, also stands disposed of.
