Prayer in this application is for restoration of the main petition on its original number which was dismissed for non-prosecution on 05.03.2024.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to just exceptions. The main revision petition is restored to its original number and the same is taken on Board.

1. Prayer in this revision petition is for issuance of directions to the learned Family Court, Moga, to decide the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred as 'HMA') filed by the

petitioner in a case bearing No. HMA-421/2021 titled as Dimple Walia vs. Inderpreet Singh Sidhu, within reasonable time.

2. Considering the limited scope of prayer, issuance of notice to the respondent is dispensed with.

3. Heard. Paper-book perused with the assistance of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. It is a matter of record that the petitioner has filed a petition under Section 13 of HMA against the respondent. Various zimni orders placed on record as Annexure P-4, the status report dated 29.08.2023 given by Principal Judge, Family Court, Moga in pursuance of order dated 09.08.2023 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench as well as the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the divorce petition is now pending for evidence of the petitioner show that the proceedings are going on in the petition.

5. At this stage, no case is made out to give directions to the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Moga. However, this Court is optimistic and confident that learned Family Court shall make sincere endeavour to dispose of the petition expeditiously without giving any undue adjournments. Needless to mention, parties to the petition shall assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

7. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
