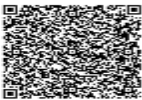

1. By this common order, the above-noted petitions are hereby
adjudicated as issues involved and prayer sought in all the petitions are



common. For the sake of convenience and with the consent of parties, the facts are borrowed from CWP-26952-2018.

2. The petitioner is assailing award dated 29.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by Labour Court, Ambala.
3. The Labour Court by impugned order had ordered to reinstate the workman with continuity of service and 50% back wages. The respondent-State of Haryana filed *Civil Writ Petition No.29486 of 2018* titled as ‘*Government of Haryana, Forest Department Vs. Sh. Dharampal and another*’ before this Court assailing reinstatement with 50% back wages. The petitioner is claiming full back wages.
4. In the wake of statement of both sides, *Civil Writ Petition No.29486 of 2018* was disposed of vide order dated 03.10.2024 passed by this Court.
5. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that in view of disposal of *Civil Writ Petition No.29486 of 2018*, the instant petition has rendered infructuous.
6. Petitions stand disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
