Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that against the impugned order dated 01.01.2024 (Annexure P-1), the applicant-petitioner intended to file an appeal so as to challenge the same but could not seek liberty at the time of passing of the order dated 31.01.2024 and therefore, liberty be also granted to the applicant-petitioner to challenge the order dated 01.01.2024 (Annexure P-1), by which, the punishment has been imposed, by filing an appropriate appeal.

4. Mr. Saurabh Girdhar, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
