Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that some of the petitioners have gained the required qualification of ETT though, after the last date of the application form and at least, those candidates can be treated eligible as a special case by the respondents. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners will raise the said plea before the authorities concerned by filing appropriate representation and respondents be directed to decide the said issue by taking a compassionate view with regard to the candidates who have already passed the ETT as of now.
