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**AMARJOT BHATTI J.**

1. Petitioners - Basant and Jatin have filed instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.293 dated 10.07.2024, under Sections 115, 126, 3(5), 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. As per facts of the case Ramesh Tawar @ Ramesh Kumar Tanwar complainant gave his statement that he is press photographer of Punjab Kesari. On 10.07.2024 at about 6:45 PM, two boys came with two girls in the temple and they were indulging in wrongful activity within the temple premises. The complainant objected to their conduct and started walking towards the temple. Said boys stopped him on the way and gave beating. He received injuries on his face and eyes. On alarm raised by him, people reached there. Said assailants managed to escape on their motorcycle



No.HR-08J-1890 by giving threats to kill him. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Petitioners filed this petition for quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. Petitioners and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. Detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Kaithal dated 07.09.2024. Statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, where he confirmed the compromise with petitioners. He confirmed that this compromise has been effected with their free consent and without any fear or pressure from any side and he has no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

4. Petitioners Basant and Jatin also confirmed this fact in their separate statements. Statement of SI Subhash Chand is also recorded who further confirmed that accused are not involved or declared as proclaimed offender in any other criminal case.

5. Therefore, from the report of Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Kaithal, it is clear that compromise has been effected between parties with their free consent and without any fear or pressure, which is acceptable to both the parties.

6. Considering all these factors in mind, in the case in hand both parties have mutually settled their dispute. It would enable them to live in peace and harmony and end all litigation started between them. Thus, no purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

7. Therefore, considering these facts, petition filed by petitioners is accepted and FIR No.293 dated 10.07.2024, under Sections

115, 126, 3(5), 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arisen therefrom is quashed qua petitioners.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
