1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.83 dated 26.01.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.
2. Vide order dated 05.08.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.08.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the petitioner has distorted the facts while seeking anticipatory bail.



6. In view of the above, interim order dated 05.08.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Petition stands allowed.
