PANKAJ JAIN J, (ORAL)

1. Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 29.05.2019 (Annexure P-1), whereby application filed by the claimants under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC seeking amendment of the petition has been declined.

2. Claimants filed application seeking amendment only with respect to the names of the claimants and proposed amendment are as under:-

- 1. Smt. Ravinderjit Kaur aged about 30 years W/o Late Bhupinderjit Singh.*
- 2. Jaskaran Singh minor son aged about six years S/o Late Bhupinderjit Singh (Minor through his mother Smt. Ravinderjit Kaur being his natural guardian).*
- 3. Jasleen Kaur minor aged about three years daughter of Late Bhupinderjit Singh (Minor through her mother Smt. Ravinderjit Kaur being her natural guardian).*



4. *Jasvir Kaur w/o Terjinder Singh aged 63 years. All R/o Chauni Kalan, P. S. Sadar, Ram Colony Camp, Hoshiarpur. In the head note of the petition as well as in whole petition wherever the names are mentioned therein.”*

3. Counsel for the respondent no.3 is not in a position to dispute that the proposed amendment will have no effect on the merits of the case and are mere typographical mistakes in nature. The purpose and object of Order 6 Rule 17 CPC has been elaborated by Apex Court in the case of Life Insurance Corporation of India v. Sanjeev Builders Private Limited and another, 2022 AIR Supreme Court 4256.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid parameters of law and the nature of amendment proposed, this Court is of the considered opinion that the Tribunal fell in error in denying the application filed by the claimants seeking amendment.

5. Resultantly, the present revision petition is allowed. Impugned order is set aside and the application filed by the claimants under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC is ordered to be allowed.

6. Counsel for the respondents very fairly submits that the amount shall be paid to the claimants within a period of 8 weeks’.
