1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that petitioner has not been given promotion from the due date in the Cadre of Senior Assistant and Superintendent Grade-II as well as further promotion to the post of Traffic Manager, hence, respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit of promotion as Senior Assistant as well as Superintendent Grade-II as also the post of Traffic Manager from the date the petitioner is entitled for.
2. Further prayer of the petitioner is that the legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) which the petitioner has filed raising the same claim, be decided in a time bound manner.
3. The interest of justice will be served in case the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.



4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and will be duly conveyed to him.

6. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction that appropriate decision on the legal notice dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner be taken by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.
