JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of transfer order whereby they have been transferred from Gateman/Gatekeeper to Gangmen.

2. Mr. Anil Chawla, Senior Panel Counsel submits that petitioner Nos. 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13 and 14 have not been transferred, thus, they cannot claim any grievance against respondents. All others including Jasvir Singh and Jaspal Singh have joined.

3. Mr. Gursharanjit Singh, Advocate expressed his inability to controvert statement of Mr. Anil Chawla, Senior Panel Counsel, however, submitted that Jasvir Singh and Jaspal Singh have filed another petition.

4. Disposed of accordingly.

5. The disposal of the present petition would not prejudice to claim of Jaspal Singh and Jasvir Singh who statedly have filed separate writ petition and interim order in their favour has been passed.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
