SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the circular dated 25.09.2018, Annexure P3, issued by respondent No.3 whereby some restrictions have been imposed upon the petitioner and some similarly placed unions.

2. Upon notice by this Court, writ petition has been contested



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by the respondents by filing reply by way of affidavit of Additional Registrar (1), Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh, wherein it has been submitted that the impugned circular, Annexure P3, has been amended vide letter dated 26.10.2018, Annexure R1/T. Its relevant extract is reproduced hereunder:

“The following amendment is hereby made in respect of Letter No.RCS/MS-3/L.C Amritsar/46A Dated 25.09.2018 issued by this department on the subject cited above:-

“In case any Labour and Construction Society gets work in another District after obtaining tender then it has to obtain No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the concerned Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies.”

Apart from this, it is also directed that the NOC, which would be issued by concerned Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, copy of the same shall be sent to District Manager of the concerned L.C Union.”

3. In view of the above, grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

4. Writ petition is disposed of.
