The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry/investigation in case bearing FIR No.0062 dated 05.07.2024 under Sections 64/3(5)/351(2)/137(2) of BNS registered at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has solemnized marriage with one, Balwinder Kumar @ Goldi on 18.01.2024 by converting her religion from Muslim to Hindu on 17.01.2024 against the wishes of her parents. Thereafter, they both have approached this Court seeking protection and the same has been disposed of vide order dated 23.01.2024 (Annexure P-3). Subsequently, family members of the petitioner have filed a miscellaneous application bearing No. CRM-W-213 of 2024 and CRM-W-214-2024 for recalling the said order of protection but since the Court was not inclined, they have withdrawn the same. He further submits that after one month of marriage, the parents of the petitioner showed their gesture that they admits her marriage with Balwinder Kumar and allured her to come back to meet her mother as she was ill and when the petitioner went to her parental home, all the family members have beaten her up mercilessly and shifted her in the house of her maternal aunt at Village Mojowal, P.O. Bhangala. She

contacted her husband and her husband got her back on 29.06.2024. Thereafter, the family members of the petitioner hatched a criminal conspiracy against the husband of the petitioner on account of their grudge against him and moved a false complaint on the concocted facts from the cousin sister of the petitioner, namely, Nazia. Further, the petitioner has filed representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) in this regard to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
