1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that selection process undertaken in pursuance to the Advertisement No. 4 of 2019 is totally arbitrary and illegal as, the entitled reservation had not been provided for various categories and Rule 32 of the Haryana Civil Services (Executive Branch) Rule 2008 has been violated.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, submits that though a grievance is being raised qua Advertisement No. 4 of 2019 but no such grievance was raised by the petitioners when the said Advertisement was issued and now the selection process is already over and the selected candidates are working but none of the selected

candidate, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the present petition, have been impleaded hence, the present petition is liable to be dismissed on this ground.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by impleading all the relevant parties, who will be affected by the outcome of the prayer of the petitioners.

4. Ordered accordingly.
