**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.04.2022 passed in RA-CW-495-2017.
2. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that pursuant to the order dated 19.04.2022 passed in RA-CW-495-2017, the petitioner has been reinstated into service and payment of 50% back-wages, as ordered by the Writ Court, has also been made to the petitioner. Copy of letter, produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
5. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
