1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release/refund the final payment of CPF deducted from the salary of the petitioners and deposited in their Permanent Retirement Account Number (PRAN).
2. Learned State Counsel on instructions has submitted that as per their stand, amount due to the petitioners has already been paid and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Although, the case has been called twice but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in order to rebut the abovesaid aspect. None had appeared on 19.07.2023 also.
4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Liberty is however granted to the petitioners to revive the present writ petition in case any cause survives to them.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
