NAMIT KUMAR J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to remove the pay anomaly of the petitioner on account of drawing less pay than his junior employee and further for re-fixation of the pay, consequential service and pensionary benefits and release of the same with interest @ 15% per annum from the date of accrual till actual payment.
2. Learned counsel for respondents No.1, 3 and 4, on the basis of letter dated 19.02.2024, submits that the case of the petitioner for removal of pay anomaly is under consideration and shall be finalized within a period of one month and necessary benefits shall be released to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.

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3. In view of the above, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present petition, if his grievance is not redressed.
