The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of regular bail to him in case arising out of FIR No.358, dated 08.09.2018, under Sections 34, 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC and under Serctions 4,5 &6 of the Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act,1978, Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad (Annexure P-1).

The Registry of the Court had raised objections on 26.10.2021, however, no learned counsel had collected the paperbook for removal of the objections. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

3. Consequently, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
