1. In compliance to the directions, issued by this Court on dated 09.08.2024, status report dated 23.09.2024, has been received from the learned trial Court, concerned, through proper channel.
2. Custody certificate dated 23.09.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel, today in the Court. The same is taken on record.
3. As per the report (supra), out of total 22 prosecution witnesses, 13 prosecution witnesses have already been examined, 08 witnesses have been given up by the learned Public Prosecutor, and only one prosecution witness is left for examination.
4. In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the relief of regular bail to the petitioner, at this stage, and considering the fact that, only one prosecution witness is left for examination, coupled with the fact that the petitioner has suffered incarceration of more than 04 years, as on today,

therefore, a mandamus is passed upon the learned trial Court concerned, to make all efforts, to conclude the trial, preferably within two months from today.
