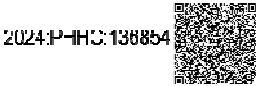

These petitions have been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioners eligible and qualified for the posts of TGT in different subjects, Rest of Haryana cadre, in response to advertisement 02/2023 dated 21.02.2023.

2. The petitioners' provisional results have been produced, which show all of them have been selected as TGTs in different subjects (ROH). However, their results have not been declared finally on account of pendency of these petitions.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that the petitioners' eligibility for which they approached this Court by filing the instant petitions is no longer in dispute. As per instructions issued by Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, vide memo dated 11.07.2024, granting relaxation in essential qualification to the candidates, the petitioners are now eligible for the posts in question. These petitions may accordingly be disposed of directing the respondents to consider the petitioners' eligibility in terms of the relaxation.
4. Learned State counsel has no objection to the prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.
5. In view thereof, the petitions are disposed of with direction to the Commission to consider the petitioners' candidature in terms of memo dated 11.07.2024, and recommend them for appointment subject to their eligibility. It is further directed that the Department shall thereafter offer appointment to the petitioners as TGT in different subjects (ROH) as per merit, subject to fulfilling the requisite conditions, with notional service benefits from the date other selected candidates pursuant to the advertisement in question have been appointed. The directions shall be carried out by the respondents within a period of four weeks of receiving a certified copy of the order.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
7. A photocopy of this order be placed on the connected case files.
