NAMIT KUMAR, J.(ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner such as gratuity, pension, leave encashment etc.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.01.2012 and during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been released the other benefits except gratuity and 1/3rd pension per month, which has been withheld by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will submit a detailed representation to the respondents for releasing the abovesaid benefits in terms of Rule 2.2 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Vol-II Part-2 and Rule 9.14 under Chapter-IX of the said rules and the same shall be considered and decided in a time bound manner. He has also submitted that similarly situated emoloyee namely Sewa Singh, J. E. has already been released the similar benefits vide order dated 30.04.2007 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that if any such

representation is given by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and final decision shall be taken at an early date.

4. Let the petitioner submit his detailed representation within a period of 4 weeks from today before the respondents. The respondents shall take a final decision thereupon within a period of 2 months thereafter by way of passing the speaking order. If the petitioner is found entitled to the retiral benefits, the same shall be released within a period of one month thereafter.

5. In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
