1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 20.04.2023 passed in CWP-2786-2003.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Darshan Singh Sidhu, Additional Director, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Since the writ Court, vide orders dated 03.11.2023 passed in CWP-24566-2023 and CWP-24661-2023, has restrained the respondents from proceeding further and has stayed the relieving order, therefore, this

Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the present contempt petition.

4. Dismissed, at this stage.
5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, in case the above-said orders dated 03.11.2023 are ever vacated or the decision in the aforesaid writ petitions goes in their favour.
