This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the show cause notice, dated 09.07.2024, Annexure P-11, whereby the petitioner has been called upon to explain his conduct and behaviour.

2. As apparent on record, the petitioner was working as an Assistant Professor on contract basis in the University since 2017. There were certain complaints against him by the students, whereupon a fact finding inquiry was conducted by the Committee constituted for the purpose. Its report dated 27.03.2024, Annexure P-13, has been appended to the petition. Based upon the findings and recommendations of the Committee, the impugned show cause notice, dated 09.07.2024, was issued to the petitioner.



3. Learned counsel for the respondent/University contends that the petitioner has submitted reply to the show cause notice as well, and he has been called for personal hearing on 27.08.2024. Thereupon, appropriate decision in the matter will be taken by the competent authority. It is also contended that as of now the petitioner is not in service, as his contract stands terminated with effect from 14.06.2024.

4. In this view of the matter, apparently the petition is premature, and stands disposed of as such.
