1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent no.3 and 4 who are harassing the petitioners and giving threats to involve them and their family member in false NDPS case. Further to direct the respondent no.3 and 4 and his officers not to harass the petitioners and their family members without any cogent cause of reason. With further prayer to issue directions to respondent no.2 to direct respondent no.3 and 4 not enter the house of the petitioners in odd hours without lady Police officials. With a further prayer to take necessary action as per law on the representation dated 22.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioners are not involved in any case, however, their son is involved in one NDPS case and on account of the same, the police officials are harassing the petitioners.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on

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behalf of the respondent-State. On instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, he has submitted that no harassment as alleged is being caused by the Police, however, son of the petitioners is required in the NDPS case and in that case necessary investigation is being carried out in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
