The petitioner, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 03.04.2024 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 6869 of 2024.

[2] In response, learned counsel for the respondent has produced a copy of speaking order dated 04.09.2024 passed by the Executive Engineer, Provincial Division PWD (B&R), Hoshiapur, which is taken on record and the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite. In the aforesaid order, the claim of petitioner has been accepted in part.

[3] To this, learned counsel for the respondent assures / undertakes that the necessary payment shall be made to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

[4] In view of aforesaid assurance / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[5] **Disposed off as not pressed.**

[6] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition by instituting an appropriate application, and on the day of its listing, the officer concerned shall remain present in Court besides it, he / she shall bear the costs of Rs.50,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioner from his / her own pocket.

[7] Also, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy regarding the relief which has been declined by the respondents, as per law.
