Present application has been filed for recalling the order dated 17.07.2024, by which, the present writ petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Mr. Charan Preet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. The order dated 17.07.2024 is recalled and the writ petition is restored to its original number and status.



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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the departmental proceedings have been withdrawn but the claim of the petitioner with regard to the grant of handicapped allowance has not been decided so far and the respondents be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order on the release of the handicapped allowance in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.
2. Learned State counsel submits that appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner for the release of the handicapped allowance will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to the petitioner otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
4. Ordered accordingly.
