NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the orders dated 29.07.2013 (Annexure P-3), 12.12.2014 (Annexure P-9) and Resolution No.42 dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-12), whereby the petitioner was placed under suspension and further his appeal was rejected without any show cause notice/inquiry.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the LRs of the petitioner and for that reason they have also not been brought on record.



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3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LR's of the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
