VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-9) and order dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-7).

2. During the course of the arguments on account of the fact that the impugned orders dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-7) and dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-9) are cryptic and non-speaking, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondents no.1 and 2 have jointly submitted that both the said orders be set aside and respondent no.4

be directed to re-decide the case. Learned counsel for both the parties have

submitted that liberty be granted to both the parties to raise all pleas as available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances and the joint statement made on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondents no.1 and 2, the impugned orders dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-7) and dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-9), which are apparently cryptic and non-speaking, deserve to be set aside and are set aside and respondent no.4 is directed to reconsider the matter, in accordance with law, after granting full opportunity to both the parties to raise all pleas, as are available to them in law. The present petition is disposed of in the above said terms.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent no.4 is directed to decide the case independently, in accordance with law.
