1. The challenge in the present appeal is to the interim order dated 11.07.2024 passed by the learned Single Judge in CWP-13042-2024.
2. Learned senior counsel for the appellant has vehemently argued that effect of the said order amounts to allowing the writ petition.
3. We have gone through the order passed by learned Single Judge. The present appellant, who was respondent no.5 before the learned Single Judge, has yet to file the written statement.
4. Keeping in view the above, when pleadings are yet to be completed before the learned Single Judge, we are of the considered opinion that the appellant can always press for the final disposal of the writ petition after the pleadings are complete. Therefore, we are not inclined to interfere in the impugned order.

5. In view of the above, learned senior counsel for the appellant prays for withdrawal of the appeal with liberty to take recourse of remedies available to him in accordance with law and by completing the pleadings before the learned Single Judge.
6. Prayer is allowed.
7. Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
