SANJAY VASHISTH, J.(Oral)

1. On instructions from Mr. Vijay Kumar, Manager HR, State Bank of India, Sri Muktsar Sahib, learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 submits that the Bank has agreed to pay lump sum amount of Rs.1,00,000/- towards all the claims raised by the petitioner.

2. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has received the required instructions in this regard and accepts the proposal given by the Bank. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that if the agreed amount of Rs.1,00,000/- is paid to the petitioner, she would be happily satisfied with her claim and would not raise any further claim in future in regard to the services rendered by her with respondent-Bank.

3. In view of the submissions made by the parties, nothing requires to be adjudicated, thus, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 (jointly) to pay an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (one lac) to the petitioner, in the shape of demand draft or by transferring the same in her account within a period of ten days from today, in compliance of the submissions recorded hereabove.
