1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to quash the order dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), passed by the Court of Sessions Judge, Kapurthala in case FIR No.0032 dated 26.06.2018 under Sections 379-B, 411, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, whereby, the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of interim order dated 05.08.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has already surrendered before the Court and is regularly appearing before the trial Court. Moreover, the petitioner has also deposited a cost of Rs.2,000/- in the account of the Society for the Care of the Blind.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that

the petitioner had not intentionally appeared before the trial Court and the petition is liable to be dismissed.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 05.08.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not remain absent from the trial Court proceedings, without prior permission of the trial Court.
