1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 06.07.2023 passed in CWP-14080-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Ghanshyam Thori, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, District Amritsar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 06.07.2023 passed in CWP-14080-2023 has been complied with and the application dated 30.05.2023 filed by the petitioner has been decided.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
