1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.04.2018 passed in CWP-9280-2018.

2. Affidavit of Rajiv Rattan, IAS, Director Higher Education, Haryana, compliance report by way of affidavit of Navneet Gupta, Principal Accountant General (A & E), Haryana, and the reply on behalf of respondent No.4, filed in the Registry, are taken on record.

- 3. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the claim of the petitioner has already been decided even before filing of the present petition but after the order of the Writ Court.

- 6. Dismissed.
- 7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
