Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.55 dated 29.01.2022, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act'), at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

2. Allegations are that 52 kg 360 grams of ganja was recovered from the petitioner and other co-accused.

3. At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions, has apprised the Court that out of 18 prosecution witnesses, 17 have already been examined and as such, trial is at the fag end.

4. In view of the above and especially that heavy quantity of contraband was allegedly recovered from the petitioner as well as other co-accused, present petition is disposed off with the observation that learned trial Court shall proceed in the matter expeditiously, without

granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and progress report be sent to the Registry by 31.03.2024.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
