The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.259 dated 25.10.2022 under Sections 21/23 of the NDPS Act (Sections 25/27(a), 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) and Sections 10/11/12 of the Aircraft Act 1934 registered at Police Station Chehharta, Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 03.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 03.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 03.11.2023 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
