MAIN CASE

The petitioners, thirteen (13) in number, have filed the present contempt petition under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Court Act seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 16.04.2024 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 8333 of 2024.

[2] Upon advance notice, Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and informs that pursuant to the order dated 16.04.2024 (supra), the names of

petitioners have already been brought on the portal of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam vide order dated 03.06.2024. He, thus, submits that no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.
