The present petition has been filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent/contemnor for intentionally, wilfully and deliberately violating order dated 03.04.2024 passed by this Court in CWP 7486-2024 titled as ‘Sanjeet and others vs State of Haryana and others’.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana and Mr. Harkesh Kumar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that grievance of the petitioners qua bringing their names on the portal of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam, as ordered by the writ Court, already stood redressed and nothing survives in the present petition.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
