The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 11.04.2024 under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.08.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit dated 19.08.2024 of Mr. Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur in the court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.08.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.



In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.08.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
