By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
371	25.04.2024	406, 420, 120-B of IPC	Sector 58, District Faridabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 28.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 28.08.2024.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from SI Rajpal, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.
4. Mr. Pradeep Panwar, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed power of attorney. He opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.



5. During the course of hearing on 28.08.2024 , following order was passed:

“ After hearing the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel assisted by SI Rajpal, Investigating Officer of the case, it transpires that no amount has been transferred in the name of the petitioner nor is he signatory of any documents or beneficiary thereof.

List on 12.09.2024.

In the meanwhile, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 28.08.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 28.08.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.



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7. The petition stands allowed.
8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not
be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
