AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 25 days in filing and 118 days in refiling the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing and refiling the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.1,25,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellant-Suresh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.1,25,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) favouring appellant-Suresh s/o Sh. Nafe Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.03.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of

the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of

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the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
