1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 04.05.2012, Annexure P-7, through which the Non Practice Allowances (NPA) has been stopped and order dated 12.04.2017, Annexure P-8, through which the service period of the petitioner with effect from 15.05.2015 to 28.07.2015 treated as dies-non.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that NPS being paid to the petitioner was stopped.

3. Learned State counsel refers para 9 of the written statement, which reads as under:-

“9. That the State Government by taking a serious view of attempting the exoneration of Dr. Manjit Singh Bajwa by constituting a committee at the level of Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana has also directed the Director Health Services to fix responsibility of officer/officials of the Department vide letter dated 08.02.2018. Copy of the letter is annexed as Annexure R-2. The charge sheet

against the petitioner has also been issued. Necessary decision regarding restoration of the N.P.A. to the petitioner would be taken after the conclusion of departmental proceedings.”

4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner who prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage.
5. Ordered accordingly.
