1 On 21.08.2023, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had adjourned the matter on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioners. Thereafter on 28.11.2023, a written request for adjournment was filed on behalf of the petitioners and the case was adjourned to 24.01.2024. On 24.01.2024, another written request for adjournment was filed by the learned counsel for the petitioners and the matter was adjourned to 23.05.2024. On 30.05.2024, another written request for adjournment was filed and the Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

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There is a written request for an adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner as he is unwell.
