1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner through Special Power of Attorney, who is appearing in person, with the grievance that petitioner is 70 years old and is unable to move freely and the benefit which her late husband was entitled for qua the revision of his pension as well as the consequent revision of the family pension, which the petitioner is entitled to after the death of her husband, has not been granted, hence, the respondents be directed to grant the benefit of the revision of the pension of the husband as well as the revision of the family pension along with arrears and interest. The further prayer is that the revised gratuity which has been released to the petitioner should also carry interest.

2. Learned special power of attorney holder for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 03.02.2023 (Annexure P-2) but the same is still pending



consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 03.02.2023 (Annexure P-2) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.
5. Learned special power of attorney holder for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
6. Ordered accordingly.
