



that the petitioner has been named in the disclosure statement of his co-accused. Other than that there is no corroborative additional evidence available against him.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 06.08.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating officer. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that although the petitioner is involved in a criminal case registered under Indian Penal Code, however, he has no involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has not disputed the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned State counsel has further submitted that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, present petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.08.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.PC/482 of BNSS, 2023.
