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The matter has been again discussed.

These are two appeals; one has been filed by Reliance General Insurance Company Limited and another has been filed by the claimants-appellants.

The matters have been compromised. Statements of learned counsel for both the parties have been recorded separately. As per statement of learned counsel for the Insurance Company, appeal filed by the Insurance Company stands dismissed as withdrawn.

In the appeal filed by the Insurance Company, Hon'ble High Court stayed disbursement of the award passed by MACT beyond ₹4,50,000/- and the amount of ₹4,50,000/- was already paid by the respondent-Insurance Company to the claimants-appellants. Now, Insurance Company is ready to pay ₹9,00,000/- more over and above the amount already paid as per award of MACT i.e. ₹4,50,000/- in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned

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counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 –
Mandeep Kaur wife of Paramjit Singh.

Accordingly, appeal filed by the claimants-appellants stands disposed of with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-
cheque for ₹9,00,000/- (₹ Nine Lakh Only) in the name of appellant No.1 -
Mandeep Kaur wife of Paramjit Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of
the High Court on or before 31.05.2024, in compliance of this order, failing
which interest @ 9% shall follow on this amount from the date of this order
till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall
issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned
counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The
appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of
the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and
file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
