KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. On 10.8.2023, the following order was passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.:-

“Learned counsel submits that petitioner was summoned to face trial under Sections 323, 341, 506, 294 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Raikot, Ludhiana Rural. He was admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds. However, on 08.09.2021 as the trial proceeded, notice was issued to petitioner to remain present in Court on the next date of hearing. According to learned counsel, petitioner could not appear before learned trial Court on the next two dates of hearing i.e. 11.02.2022 and 05.05.2022, as he was living in Sweden and no notice was communicated to him. As a result, bailable warrants and non-bailable warrants for securing the presence of the petitioner were issued. However, the same were also never communicated to the petitioner, pursuant to which, impugned order dated 19.01.2023 (Annexure P-8), declaring him proclaimed

On the asking of Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Addl.A.G., Punjab joins proceedings and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before learned trial Court within four weeks from today and on his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Court below.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has caused appearance and he has been released on regular bail and he is continuously appearing before the learned trial Court concerned.

3. In view of the above fact since the petitioner is appearing before the learned trial Court concerned, therefore, no further action is required in the instant petition and the same is, hereby, **dismissed** as having rendered infructuous.
